How to find us

By Foot or Bike: Solihull Station is a 5 minute walk away. Bike racks are available at Sapphire East.

By Rail: National Rail Enquiries Line 08457 484950.
From Birmingham New Street – Transfer to Moor Street Station for local train which runs every 20 minutes to Solihull Station. **From Birmingham International** – Taxi to Solihull or Bus Service 966 that runs every 30 minutes. **From London Marylebone** – direct to Solihull.

By Bus/Coach: For information – Tel: 0121 200 2700. From New Street take services 37 which run every 10 minutes to Solihull or transfer from New Street to Moor Street Station and take the 57 to Solihull. All Solihull buses go to Solihull Station, which is a 5 minute walk from the office.

By Road: From Birmingham – Follow Stratford (A34)/ Solihull (A41), at Camp Hill roundabout follow Stratford Road (A34).

After 4 miles, pass Robin Hood pub, and at the island take the 2nd left to Solihull Lane (B4025) and Streetsbrook Road. After 3 miles with Broad Oaks Road (on left), Sapphire East is on the right before the fire station. **From M42, J5** – Follow Solihull (A41) and bear left for Solihull Town Centre (B4025). At the roundabout turn right for Town Centre, through several sets of traffic lights, Morrisons and the O'Neils Pub (on left). At the roundabout turn left into Lode Lane (B4102). At the next roundabout turn right into Streetsbrook Road (4th exit) for Birmingham B4025. Go straight on at traffic lights, past fire station, Sapphire East is on the left. There are 7 visitor car spaces or parking is available at Lode Lane multi-storey, 10 minutes walk away.
